## **Announcing the 19th Annual Stars of Tomorrow Vocal Scholarship Competition APPLY NOW!**

**South Coast Singers** is a non-profit community choir in Orange County, CA, whose musical mission is to give back to its surrounding communities through performance and outreach programs. Almost two decades ago, South Coast Singers created an annual event known as Stars of Tomorrow and has since given away more than \$85K in vocal scholarship awards. Considered one of Orange County's premier vocal scholarship programs, Stars of Tomorrow provides an opportunity for students attending Orange County high schools (public or private) to compete for scholarship money intended to assist them in pursuing their vocal career goals.

Students may submit an audition packet (including a video audition) for one of two categories: Classical or Musical Theatre. Ten semi-finalists for each category will be chosen, then judged by a panel of three industry professionals who will select three winners for each category. Last year, \$4,500 in total scholarship money was awarded. First place winners will perform and receive their award at one of the South Coast Singers Spring Concerts to be held on June 7 and June 14.
